Managing Blessings: Teacher, Ashley Williams. Community Room B.

This is a group of couples and singles in their late 20's to 40's who meet with the goal of fellowship and expanding their faith and understanding of God. They have lively and honest discussion covering contemporary and religious studies. They try to have breakfast every Sunday too!

One Accord: Teacher, Daryl Jones. Community Room A.

One Accord uses *Adult Bible Study Curriculum* (United Methodist literature) and is a group of men and women. They are supportive, thought provoking and encourage class discussion that will increase their hope and faith and foster love.

J.O.Y Class: Teachers, Kaye Breeding and Jennifer Borders. Room 105.

This class is a group of women who love the Lord. They alternate studying a book of the Bible and an inspirational book. They are caring, supportive, sensitive to each other's needs, serious learners, searchers, welcoming, and fun. And they have occasional socials!

This is a group of men and women of all ages and backgrounds. They have lively and honest discussion covering contemporary and religious studies using a variety of books and Bible study literature.
