***Breaking the Code* by Bruce M. Metzger.** The book of Revelation contains passages of great beauty and comfort, as well as passages that strike the casual reader as bizarre, bewildering, and sometimes frightening. This study serves as a guide to understanding this powerful and puzzling book so full of rich symbolism. Video and discussion. ***Seeking Allah, Finding Jesus: A Devout Muslim Encounters Christianity* by Nabeel Qureshi.** A former Muslim shares his evidence that led him to Jesus Christ. This is a really powerful study!

***Across the Spectrum: Understanding Issues in Evangelical Theology* by Gregory A. Boyd and Paul R. Eddy.** Predestination, Creation, Inspiration of Scripture, etc., there are several issues within Christianity in which there is no consensus among scholars. Great thinkers can read the Bible and come away with varying understandings of certain issues. In this book, the authors explore some of the most disagreed upon issues and lay out the biblical, theological, and philosophical arguments for each position in point-counterpoint fashion and discuss possible objections. Our class will explore these issues while resting on the assurance that in the end, it is ok to agree to disagree. Cost of book is \$12. **Led by Jeremy Arnold in Room 106.**

***What Love Is; The Letters of 1, 2, 3 John* by Kelly Minter.** The letters of 1, 2, & 3 John were written to encourage followers of Jesus to remain faithful to the truth. Believers are challenged to look at contrasting themes such as walking in the light instead of darkness, truth versus lies and deception, loving God more than loving the world, and the meaning of true fellowship and community rather than shallowness. ***Letters to Malcolm Chiefly on Prayer* by C.S. Lewis.** "Joy is the serious business of heaven" is just one quote from this delicious book on prayer.
